

Jelena Bazova studied at the state conservatory in Kazan (Russia) the major subjects piano and organ. These studies were crowned with both soloist diplomas as with the Prix d'Excellence in 1980. In 1991 she was a laureate of the Russian national organ competition. From 1980 to 1990 she taught piano at the state conservatory in Astrakhan (in southern Russia). She was a piano and organ teacher at the state conservatory in Kazan from 1990 to 1997. Jelena Bazova gave countless concerts through whole Russia, also for radio and television. She gave several concerts in Europe in Holland, Belgium, France (for instance in the Nôtre Dame of Paris), Italy (for instance in the St. Peter in Rome) and Germany. She interpreted works of modern composers during the festivals of contemporary music ("Moscow Autumn", "the White Nights " of St. Petersburg and "Europe-Asia" in Kazan). She has lived and worked in Holland since 1997. She is the organist of the renowned Sacraments choir in Breda. Several times she gave concerts for piano and organ on the Belgian and Dutch radio. Several CDs appeared in Holland.

She is a piano teacher at the Fontys conservatory in Tilburg. Several of her students won prizes at competitions, such as the National Concours of SJMN (Stichting Jong Muziektalent Nederland), International Steinway & Sons Concours, the Prinses Christina Concours, the YPF (Young Pianist Foundation) concours and other international competitions.
